RUNNERS WHO WISH TO RECEIVE A GUARANTEED ENTRY THROUGH THE S.L.E. LUPUS FOUNDATION

FUNDRAISING COMMITMENT:

Marathon

- October 1, 2011** \$150 Commitment Fee is due upon signing up to participate on our team. Registration fee needs to be paid before training begins.
- January 1, 2012** \$500 needs to be raised in order for us to process your LA Marathon Race Registration. **If you do not meet this fundraising deadline, you will have to register yourself for the LA Marathon.**
- February 1, 2012** \$1000. All fundraising minimums should be met at this time.

The fundraising commitment is \$300. Participants are asked to raise the minimum fundraising amount (\$100) by March 1, 2012 and meet the fundraising timeline due dates.

- January 15, 2012** \$50 Commitment Fee is due upon signing up to participate on our team. Registration fee needs to be paid before training begins.
- February 1, 2012** \$100 needs to be raised in order for us to process your LA Marathon Race Registration.
- March 1, 2012** \$200. All fundraising minimums should be met at this time.

Virtual Team

The fundraising suggested minimum is \$100.

- March 1, 2012** Virtual team members can register at any time prior to March 1, 2012. It is recommended that virtual team members sign up as soon as possible so they can begin fundraising.

MATCHING GIFT POLICY: Many companies match employees' charitable contributions. You can check with your employer to see if your company has this program, and ask your donors if their employers match gifts. Many companies issue matching gift checks quarterly or semi-annually, therefore, it is your responsibility to contact the matching company to ensure the check will be issued before March 30, 2012. If the companies match cycle is past March 30, 2012, the donation may not count toward your minimum.

CANCELLATION POLICY: You may cancel your participation with Team Life Without Lupus for the LA Marathon, waiving your responsibility for the \$1,000 minimum, any time on or before **December 30, 2011**. You must contact Lupus LA, in writing, to the attention of Elyse Leon-Reyes, of your cancellation. After December 30, 2011, you are responsible for raising the \$1,000 minimum, even if for any reason, including injury, you are unable to run in the Marathon. Donations raised and received by our office will not be refunded, even if you cancel before December 30, 2011.

2012 LA MARATHON TEAM LIFE WITHOUT LUPUS RUNNER AGREEMENT

RELEASE FORM AND CONTRIBUTION AGREEMENT: In consideration for my acceptance onto Team Life Without Lupus, I agree that I will not hold the Lupus LA its employees, volunteers, officers, board members, or sponsors (the "Organization") responsible for any injuries or losses I might incur while participating in the Marathon or travel to or from the Marathon or any training sessions or meetings related to my participation in the Marathon. I hereby release and discharge the Organization from any and all claims, demands, damages, actions, and I voluntarily agree to assume full risk of any and all injuries, damages, or losses I may sustain as a result of participation in the Marathon. I warrant that I have sufficiently trained for the Marathon, and that a licensed physician has verified that I am fit to participate in the Marathon. I grant permission for the use of my name, likeness, or voice and waive any compensation for said use.

I agree to collect a minimum of \$1,000 for Lupus LA and to remit to the Foundation all amounts raised by me including the minimum of \$1,000 March 30, 2012.

In the event of an illness, injury or medical emergency, I authorize the Organization to secure from any accredited hospital, clinic and/or physician any treatment deemed necessary for my immediate care. I agree that I will be fully responsible for payment of any and all medical services, ambulance transport service, and treatment rendered to me including medications and hospitalization. I represent that I have secured adequate insurance against any injury or loss that I might sustain during, or as a result of participation in the Marathon. The following should be contacted in case of an emergency.
